He visited, traveled along, or preached in Amphipolis, Antioch (of Syria, the location of Paul's home and sending church), Antioch (of Pisidia), Antipatris, Apollonia, Appian Way, Appi Forum, Arabia, Assos, Athens, Attalia, Berea, Caesarea, Cenchrea, Corinth, Cyprus, Damascus, Derbe, Ephesus, Fair Havens, Iconium, Jerusalem, Lystra, Malta, Miletus, Mitylene, Myra, Neapolis, Nicopolis, Pamphylia, Paphos, Patara, Perga, Philippi, Ptolemais, Puteoli, Rhegium, Rome, Salamis, Seleucia, Sidon, Spain*, Syracuse, Tarsus, Thessalonica, Three Taverns, Troas, Trogyllium, and Tyre. These are the places we know of.

**Spain: Some say Paul never made it that far. I think he did.*

Paul traveled the known world of his time. He made multiple journeys and preached in lots of places. He wanted to reach those who had never heard. Our ministry is modeled after Paul's.

The Extreme Mission Plan

The plan for Extreme Mission Evangelism is not to hold huge city-wide crusades. Our plan is to reach the isolated and hard to reach around the world for Christ. I want to be the one who holds out my Bible and shares the gospel with that one individual who has never once heard of Christ.

I am accountable to my pastor and the people of Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. I am guided by the wise people at the Gospel Preacher Association, our mission agency. I am encouraged by the churches that support us financially. I am grateful to my family and others who pray for us and support us.

The Extreme Mission Plan is to develop a base of operation where there is no gospel witness. These bases will not be located in population centers. Just the opposite. These areas will be remote, isolated and hard to reach. Why? Because that is our calling.

What is a base of operation? Ultimately it will be a local church. If there is no church, the isolated Christians that want to help us reach others in their area for Christ will be that base. We currently have 2 bases: Sucre, Bolivia and another in Boca del Toro, Panama. Our third will be in Central Asia, Lord willing.
