for us to get in?”**

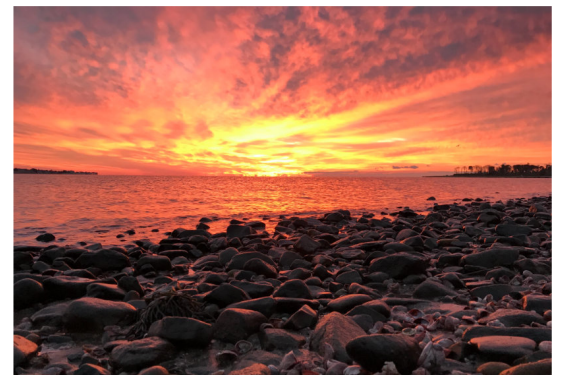

THANKS FOR EXTENDING OUR REACH

SHE STILL HASN'T HEARD

I had a vision. It repeated unexpectedly as pastor when I got up to preach to our people. I guess it wasn't a vision as much as a thought. It was an idea that emerged in my heart and it was saying, *She still hasn't heard, she still hasn't heard.*

As pastor, I would give the gospel invitation to our people in church at least three times every week. And as I was giving the invitation, I would be thinking, *She still hasn't heard, she still hasn't heard.*

The regulars at church have heard the gospel invitation thousands of times. I kept thinking of the little girl somewhere who still had not yet heard. My five daughters and one son had heard. And, for seven years while I was pastor, my church had heard of the death, burial, resurrection and extreme love of Jesus Christ.

But, *she still hasn't heard*, I repeated to myself. I began to think of all the isolated and scattered people we witnessed to when we were missionaries in Bolivia. I thought how the vast majority of the scattered people would never see a missionary, much less have a church planted in their minuscule pueblo. I knew of the vastness of isolation in other countries. How would these people ever hear of Christ?

I was restless. I knew Jesus was calling. He wanted me to personally reach those without any gospel

influence, and those with no earthly opportunity to hear about the salvation of Christ.

I spoke with wise men and women. I sought counsel from the leadership of the church where I was pastor. It took about a year and a half, but by faith I stepped out of the pastorate and into the world of missions, looking for that little girl on the edge of the jungle.

By the way, I did find her. She was on the edge of the jungle in Bocas del Toro, Panama. There is no space here to tell the whole story, but I talked to her about Jesus and she accepted Him as her Savior.

I also found “her” on the Uzbekistan-Tajikistan border. I found “her” in Bolivia last fall, and in Iceland earlier this year. By faith I will find her in other far away places as God leads.
